



This is a suggestion of how to display your new bulletin board set.


You may also choose to use string and clothes pins to display your "Accounting Class" as I did for this other set below...

I place a paper star on the Accounting Cycle step that we are currently learning to help students make connections with the accounting process...I move the star to the next step as we move on.
