



Students are immersed in Maeve's entrepreneurial dream of owning and operating her own Irish Bakery.








Students are presented with the trial balance for the bakery and prompted to prepare an income statement and balance sheet.



After completing the financial statements, students are prompted to analyze the numbers and recommend a good course of action to help Maeve increase her income and decrease her expenses.







Students are prompted to assess the difference between supplies and equipment as they drag and drop the circles on two fun, interactive slides.
