




Meg Whitman	She is the CEO of Quibi, the short-form mobile video platform, and serves on the boards of Procter & Gamble and Dropbox. Whitman previously served as President and CEO of Hewlett Packard Enterprise
Cher Wang	Cher Wang is a Taiwanese entrepreneur and philanthropist. She is considered one of the most powerful and successful women in technology.
Walt Disney	American entrepreneur, animator, voice actor and film producer. A pioneer of the American animation industry, he introduced several developments in the production of cartoons
Steve Jobs	chairman, chief executive officer, and co-founder of Apple Inc., the chairman and majority shareholder of Pixar
B. C. Forbes	Bertie Charles Forbes was a Scottish-born American financial journalist and author who founded Forbes magazine
Bill Gates	American business magnate, investor, author, philanthropist, and humanitarian. He is best known as the principal founder of Microsoft Corporation.
Robert Herjavec	Canadian businessman, investor, and television personality. A native of Varaždin, Croatia, he moved to Halifax,












They can also be used to line tack strips!

They each have a motivational quote on them and match the entrepreneurs room décor bundle.oh...I laminate them and I attach them (after each student signs the backs...with Scotch © tape)
