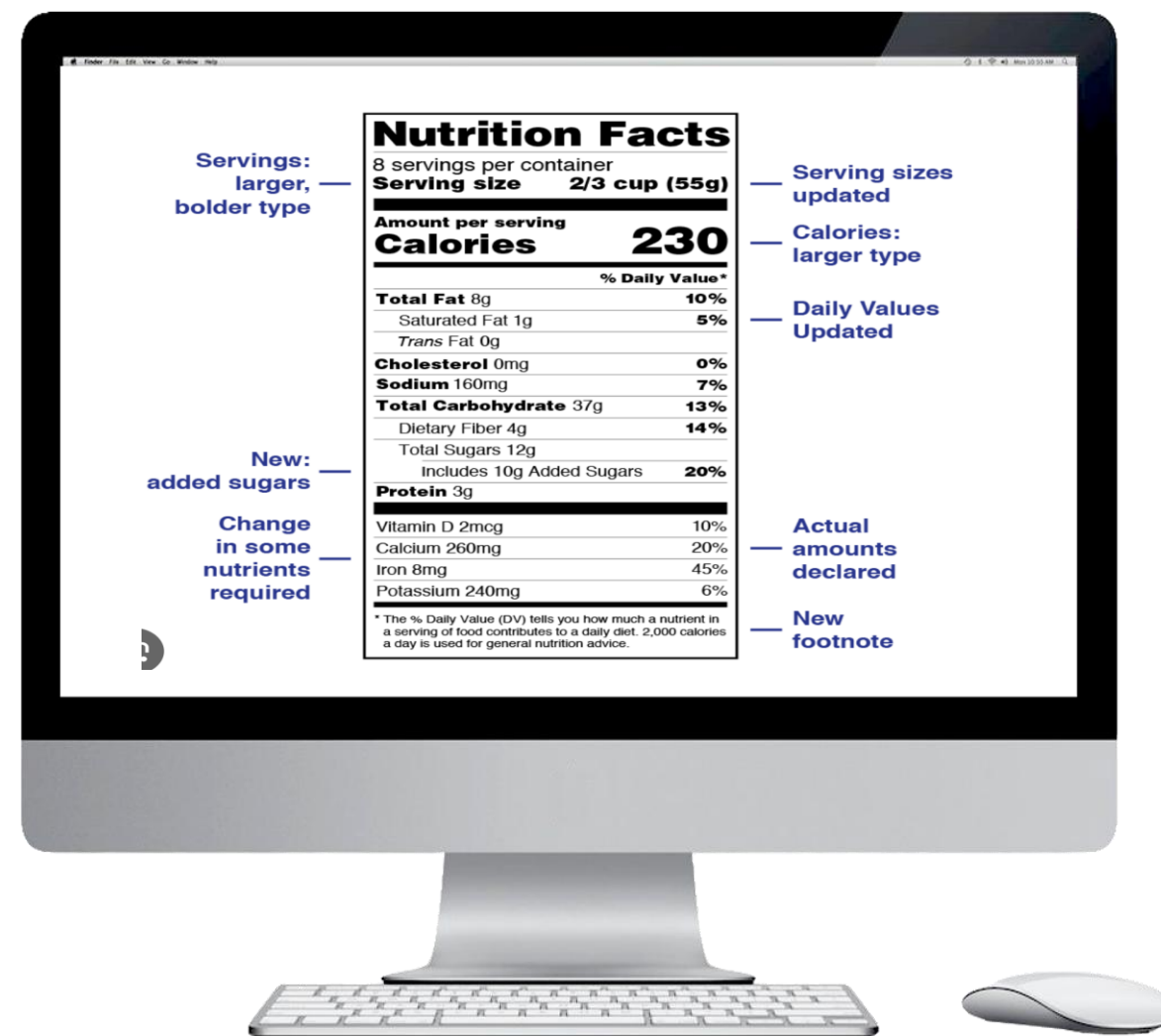

FPLA – FAIR PACKAGING AND LABELING ACT

The FPLA is a consumer act put into place to INFORM the consumer of what they are buying in every capacity within reason. Explore one of the product packages in the classroom. Evaluate what is included and what is missing on the package.
