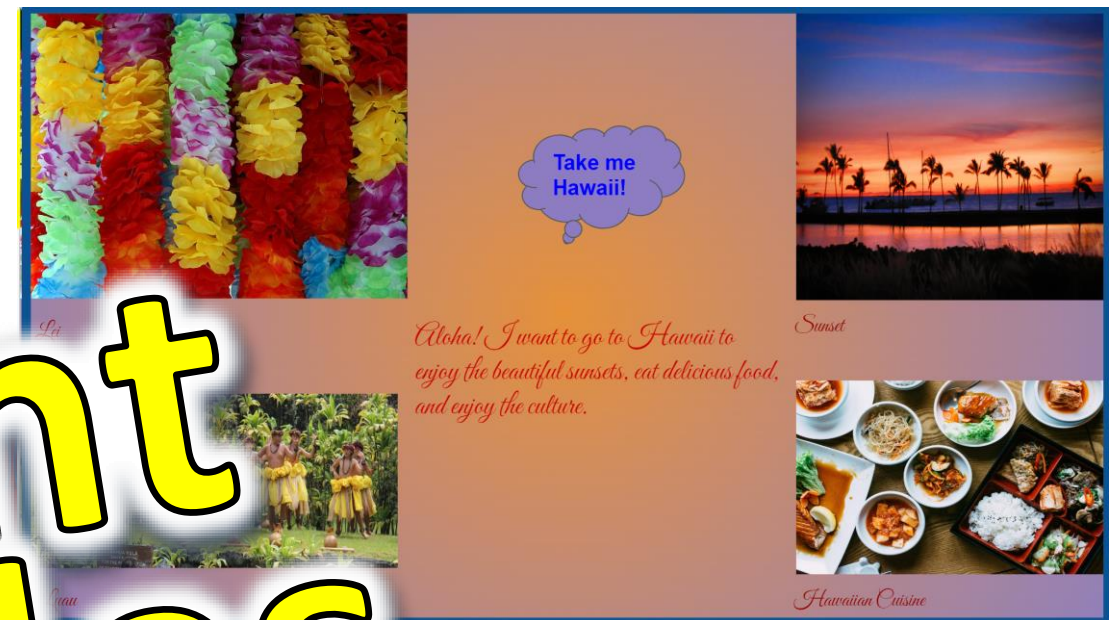



Students follow the prompts in the margins.


Function I bet you didn't know!

You MUST have the picture selected in order to do this function.





